EXAMINATION

Controller of Examination

Dr. Hukam Singh

The Theory and Practical examinations of various Under-Graduate, Post-Graduate and Engineering courses held in April/May/June/July 2017 respectively were conducted smoothly and peacefully. In addition to that supplementary/odd semester examinations of these classes were held in November/December 2017.

For smooth and efficient conduct of examinations, as many as 660 examination centres were created at the University campus and its affiliated colleges/institutions. Entrance Tests for the admissions to various courses and Centralized Admission Test for PG courses for all the State Universities for the subject which were assigned to Kurukshetra University by the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Haryana were also conducted smoothly and efficiently. For the incident free conduct of examinations full cooperation was received from the State Administration and the State Police.

During the period under report, in all 148 Research Scholars (53 male & 95 female) have been awarded Ph.D. Degree in various disciplines. About 6000 Unfair Means Cases were received in various Under-Graduate and Post-Graduate examinations held in this duration. These cases have been decided by 8 UMC committees constituted for the purpose. As many as 180 appeals were received against the decisions of the UMC Committees which have also been decided by the Appellate committees.

Steps Taken to Streamline the Examinations Branches

1. Centralized Ph.D. Entrance Test was conducted.
2. Old Results Sheets since inception of University to 2005 in first phase having 50,37,208 students were digitalized.
3. Development of Software for taking online examination form and fees which was inaugurated by the Vice-Chancellor on 1.9.2017.
4. University has conducted a training/orientation of Principals/Directors of the College's /Institute's and the staff dealing with examination work on 27.10.2017, for imparting training for use of online software and is has been implemented with the UG 1st year students.
5. On switching over to online mode, the following jobs like Preparation for Cut-Lists, Roll No.-cum-Admit Card, Centre Statements, Centre-wise question papers and Signature Charts have been computerized.
6. Date-sheets of UG/PG courses on the University Website were timely uploaded.
7. Facility of online examination forms of Engineering courses upto 3rd year and all the University Teaching Departments (CBCS System) have been put in place.
8. 41 Nodal Centres for supply of question papers and collection for answer-books on day to day basis were created.
9. Appointment of observers in each examination centre for smooth conduct of examinations was made.
10. Scanning of title page of answer-books before sending it for revaluation has been started due to the process of image scanning based technology using scanners has been initiated which has the capability of 3 in 1 functions in a single pass viz. Printing of Dummy Numbers with Bar codes. Image scanning of title OMR sheet(s) and OMR reading /capturing of data. The visible advantages of this technology are removal of manual coding and decoding system and maintain confidentiality by allotting random coding number in the following manner:-
