I am directed to inform you that the Director, Higher Education, Haryana vide letter No. KW30/3-2019 Co.(2) dated 24.06.2019 (copy enclosed) has clarified that 10% reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) will be 50% of the State Quota and will be 42.5% of the total intake (i.e. 50% of General Category out of 85% of Haryana domicile) for admission to various courses in the Educational Institutions of the Government/Government Aided/Self-financing Colleges/Institutes of Haryana.

Accordingly, the reservation policy for admissions to various courses has been revised as per Annexure-I to this letter. You are requested to make admissions for the session 2019-20 as per revised reservation policy of the State Government.

As far as block allocation Block A and Block B of Backward Classes category is concerned, year wise rotational system will adopted. For example, if Block A of Backward Classes are given seats in the Academic Year 20 the next Block i.e. B Block of category of Backward Classes will be given seats in the next academy year i.e. 2020 and so on. The concerned Chairperson/Director of the Department/Institute shadanian a roster register for horizontal reservation of Ex-servicemen/Freedom Fighter & the dependents and carry forward all fractions till one seat is accumulated through different fractions of the year. As and when the total comes to one, a seat will be provided to the concerned category.
