- b) Student Registration
- c) Centralized admission
- d) KUK Admission (Online Application only)
- e) Examination Results
- f) Accounts Using Tally
- g) College Branch (Process initiated)
- h) Employee Pay bills/salary (Partial)
- i) JN Library using LIPSYS (Partial)
- j) KUAA partial

Generally, the ERP solution for university system consist of following integrated modules:

- a) Academic module
- b) Administrative Module
- c) Financial Accounting Module
- d) Payroll and Human Resource Module
- e) Stores & Inventory Management Module
- f) Student/Alumni Management Module
- g) Course Registration Module
- h) Evaluation Module

- i) Examination module
- j) Hostel management Module
- k) Degree Module
- Affiliation Module I)
- m) Library Management Module
- **IQAC Module**

The committee observed that none of the module mentioned above is fully automated in the university, only some of them are partially automated and further they are not integrated.

The committee recommends that in order to leverage the full benefits of ERP solution such as cost cutting, transparency, data security, ease of doing etc. a complete ERP solution should be implemented to cater to the requirements of effective e-governance in the university. The existing isolated applications which are already running in the university may be integrated to the ERP solution to be implemented.
