Minutes of the Deans'Committee meeting held on 10-06-2019 at 10:30 AM in the office of Dean Academic Affairs, in persuance of resolution No. 2 (d) of the meeting of IQAC held on May 10, 2019 under the Chairmanship of the Vice-Chapcellor to resolve the issues mentioned under above resolution.

At the outset, the Dean, Academic Affairs apprised the members about the issues to be implemented w.e.f. the session 2019-20. The committee discussed the issues threadbare and recommended the following: --

- The CBCS will be extended to all campus courses including certificate, diploma, PG/Advance diploma courses w.e.f. the session 2019-20. An open elective paper of zero credit may be introduced in the courses where open elective paper of credit 2 is not feasible subject to the provisions of respective regulatory bodies. The Deans may convene the meeting of the chairpersons of their respective faculty for this purpose.
- The CBCS may be implemented for UG/PG courses in the affiliated colleges w.e.f. the session 2020-21.
- Inter-faculty open elective paper will be started for CBCS courses w.e.f. the session 2019-20.
 Every faculty will offer open elective papers for the students of other faculties.
- MOOCs may be adopted keeping in view the guidelines circulated by the academic branch vide letter no. ACS-II/moocs-19/4403-4476 dated March 28, 2019.
- MOOCs may be included in the list of open elective papers circulated by the office of Deans
 as "one paper through MOOCs/Swayam (as recommended by the Chairperson of the
 department" to their respective faculties w.e.f. the session 2019-20.
 - In order to enhance the Academia-Industry linkages, summer/ industrial training may be included in the list of open elective papers. The students can opt for summer/industrial training in lieu of class room open elective paper for 3rd semester only. This may be included in the list of open elective papers circulated by the office of Deans to their respected faculties. This may be implemented keeping in view the following:
 - The option of summer/industrial training will be included in the list of open elective papers
 of 3rd semester only.
 - The students can do the summer/industrial training only after taking permission from the chairperson of the department in writing.
 - The summer/industrial training will be of minimum 4 weeks duration and can be done only
 during summer vacations falling in the period intervening between 2nd and 3rd semester.

- The summer training can be done with an industry/research lab./company.
- Every student opting for summer training will submit a report separately and present the same before a committee of the three teachers constituted by the Chairperson of the department. The committee will award the marks out of 50 after evaluating the report and performance of the student during presentation.
- Student will append a certificate in the report from the industry/research /company where s/he has done the summer training.
- No TA/DA or stipend will be provided by the University for doing the summer training.
- Programme outcomes (POs), Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs) and Course Outcomes (COs) and their attainment will stated for all the programmes of the University. IQAC of the University will prepare a template for this purpose and circulate to all the departments.

Every department will develop a mechanism to keep the track of its students during and after the completion of the programme.
