We are looking forward to receiving your written confirmation of your participation by August 31st, 2017. Please use the confirmation form enclosed with the e-mail.

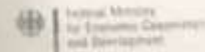

The project is a model on how a water safety plan with a component of climate change adaptation can be implemented and linked with a nutrition security concept in the region. - Quantify a detailed record of the displacement and exhumation history of the thrust belt based on interpretation of thermochronological data sets with sequential restorations of two published cross sections from the Kumaon and Garhwal region.

2.1 Programme:

There is little consensus about the respective impact of tectonic and erosion-related surface processes on the upper crustal exhumation of the Himalaya. The possibility of the evolution of the Himalaya via duplexing is a new exciting concept to understand the uplift and exhumation of the Himalaya. Under this project, sequential restorations of two published cross sections from the Kumaon and Garhwal region using thermochronological data will be studied. It will be carried out by combining new low-temperature thermochronological data generated in this project and previously published thermochronological and thermobarometric data available from the NW-Himalaya. Also, the impact of tectonics including duplex development on the exhumation across the different thrust sheets of the HHC, the Ramgarh thrust sheet and the LHS (LHMS + Crystalline klippen) in the Garhwal Himalaya during Himalayan mountain building will be explored using low temperature thermo-chronological studies (Apatite and Zircon FT and UP Th/He data).





This record is well preserved in the Late Cenozoic successions (~13Ma) of the Siwaliks. Over the years, the basin has been studied extensively with significant information on tectonics, palaeoclimate, sedimentology, and geochronology. Despite this, a knowledge gap still remains there about paleopedology, climate change, and thermochronology for the Siwaliks.

In the present project, fluvial sequences from 4 critical sections (Kathu, Nagrota, Kotla and Kangra Sections) of the Siwaliks (12Ma-5Ma) from western Panjab re-entrant will be studied using an integrated approach involving paleopedology, sedimentology and low-temperature thermochronology (fission track dating) to comprehend the role of climate change and tectonics in the evolution of the Late Cenozoic succession of the HFB.

2.2 Implementing Organization:

The project will be jointly implemented by University of Delhi, Delhi, Wadia Institute of Himalayan Geology, Dehradun and Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra.
