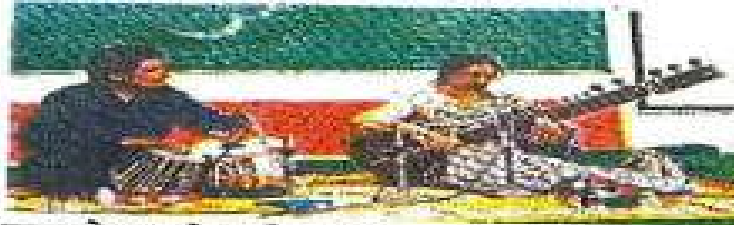
## स्वतंत्र फटाफट
