BRIEF REPORT OF VILLAGE PABNAWA **ADOPTED BY KURUKSHETRA UNIVERSITY**

As desired by Hon'ble Chancellor of Kurukshetra University and Hon'ble Governor of Haryana, vide his office letter no HRB-UA-2018/629-646 dated 19.01.2018, Kurukshetra University has adopted village Pabnawa in the month of April-2018 and the progress report of the same had been updated to the O/o Hon'ble Governor from time to time. It is humbly submitted that the office of Hon'ble Governor of Haryana has been informed time to time vide letter Nos. DSW/2018/460-61 dated 17.04.2018; DSW/2018/499-501 dated 27.04.2018; DSW/2018/288-89 dated 06.08.2018 and emails dated 24.09.2018 and 15.10.2018.

The following requests were made by the village community to the Nodal officer, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra. The University has initiated the process and persuaded the issues with the concerned Departments of State Government and District Administrations and as a result, the following have been achieved by the village:

- Kaul-Pabnawa road (length 5 km) has been constructed.
- The construction of Pirmadi road of Pabnawa has been completed.
- The bypass road of Pabnawa village has been repaired.
- The repair of Pabnawa-Jirakhera-raison road (ID-H195MC Dhand) is at final stage.
- The cleaning and development of Baba Mansa Ram Mandir has been completed in the Chhabad Panchayati land (about 4 acre) of the village in 2018 (Initiated on 27.05.2018). For further development, based on the suggestions of the Kurukshetra University, the cleaning and development of Baba Mansa Ram Mandir is presently going on.

- One water pump near Community Centre in Pabnawa village has been installed.
- The letters have been sent to the concerned Departments for construction of bus stand and restoration of Pawanhrad Tirth and approval of homeopathic dispensary in the village. The required funds for bus que shelter has already been sanctioned and deposited to the account of Zila Parishad, Kaithal. The budget estimates (11.93 lacs) for restoration of Pawanhrad Tirth has also been allocated and after the tender, 90% restoration work has been completed.

In addition to the above mentioned works undertaken with the help of public authorities, the University has also undertaken many initiatives/campaigns as detailed below:

- Awareness and Blood donation camp was organized by Kurukshetra University on 27th and 28th March, 2019 in the village.
- 7 days NSS camp from 2 January to 8 January, 2019 was organized by Kurukshetra University in the village in which various social activities were under taken. Various motivation campaigns were organized by Kurukshetra University on themes such as swachhta, plantation, 'Say NO to Drugs', female feticide etc.
- Health checkup camp was organized by Kurukshetra University in the Pabnawa village on 7.9.2018 in which total of 170 persons was checked by the doctors.
- Homeopathic health checkup camp (26.03.2019) for children up to the age of 7 was organized by Kurukshetra University in the village in which 60 children were examined by the doctors.
- All the physically challenged persons in need of Wheel Chairs were provided with Wheel Chairs by Kurukshetra University on 18.08.2019.
- One deaf and dumb child (age 10 years, 8 months) was identified from the village. His case for Cochlear implant was taken up by the University with District Red Cross Society, Kaithal. DRC Society has referred the matter to Indian Red Cross Society, Chandigarh for finance.

- One-day camp-cum-programme was conducted on 2nd October, 2019 on the theme “Say No to Single Use Plastics”.
- Constitution day was celebrated in the Govt. Sr. Sc. School, Pabnawa on 26.11.2019.
- 12 persons were motivated to attend the 3 days training program on “Entrepreneurship training in Organic Farming” to be held from 9th to 11th January, 2020 at Women Studies Research Centre, KUK organized by Centre for Entrepreneurship under RUSA 2.0.
- Distribution of masks and sanitizers to the villagers during Covid-19 lockdown.
- Earth Day celebration (22 April, 2022) was organized with the village community, Pabnawa school students and students and faculty members of Geology Department. School students were awarded and motivated through various activities.
- 07 Sewing machines were distributed by Hon'ble Chief Minister Sh. Manohar Lal Ji for Sewing Center in Pabnawa village on 14.8.2022.
- 02 Sanitary napkin incinerators were distributed by Hon'ble Governor of Haryana for the G. S. S. School, Pabnawa on 22.8.2022.
