Following this, students prepared nukkad-natak with the members and performed it at selected nukkads at a predetermined time to educate the community about the issue and its solution. Nukkad-Natak is a popular social work technique that has an impact on a wide range of groups. At the end students thanked to government school staff for their wonderful cooperation

Bal Sabha is a school event in which all children are given the opportunity to go on stage and showcase their talents by dancing or performing various cultural activities, which helps to discover children's hidden talents. With the permission and cooperation of their school's headmaster and teacher, social work students use this tool in community schools. During this process, the social worker first schedules the Bal Sabha programme. The social worker then gathers the children and teacher at the agreed-upon location and, if necessary, explains the rules of performance to the children. Then, using various techniques such as chit on name or random roll number, call children on stage and ask them to perform. This activity assists social workers in identifying children's hidden talents, bonding with one another, motivation, and initiative skills. During this process, the social worker is also able to identify the children's psychosocial problems. Finally, this activity teaches social workers how to work effectively with children, particularly those with diverse personalities. At the end social work students thanked to government school staff to cooperate with social work students in organizing various kind of activities to promote education and health.

This program successfully organized under the supervision of Dr. Vanita Dhingra (Assistant Professor). Geeta Jayanti in Kurukshetra was marked by a counselling session, Nukkad-Natak, and a rally. Stall prepared by social work students that provides information about depression symptoms and the situation when a person requires professional counselling. When a social work student discovers that people still do not want girl children and that the environment is not conducive to the normal growth and development of girls. Then, they use the Nukkad-Natak tool to sensitise people about the girl child and the existence of the lady in the family, and they try to create an environment in which community members understand the importance of women in the family, just as they understand the importance of men. Using this tool, social workers attempted to touch the emotions of community members in order to influence their thinking and behaviour. This tool not only allows you to impact a large number of people, but it also allows you to transfer emotions and talk about topics that are sensitive and difficult to discuss with people individually or in groups due to their beliefs or community environment.
