Background







<u>Report of the Seven Days Special Camp</u> <u>on the theme 'Communal Harmony'</u> <u>Village Barna</u> <u>March 21-27, 2018</u>

After dinner in the hostel the volunteers noted down their experience of the day in the camp which was to be a daily schedule and submitted at the completion of the camp.

Day 2 (22/03/2018) :-

The second day of the camp began at 6:30 a.m. with Yoga and Pranayam at the Community Centre of the university. Pankaj Rohilla, one of the participating volunteers from the Department of Physical Education and a qualified yoga instructor led the yoga activity every day during the camp. After practicing yoga for an hour the volunteers went back to their hostels for freshening up and breakfast. The volunteers again assembled at Students' Home at 9: 30 a.m. from where they were ferried to the village Barna.

The activities at the village began with the NSS Song followed by reading of the day before report by the group members who were assigned that duty. A digital awareness drive regarding the use and misuse of the applications being promoted by the government of India was carried out in the village through posters, playcards and practical mock demonstrations on the mobile handsets by the volunteers. Later on the same day a survey was also carried out by the volunteers regarding the impact of digitalization on the rural folks and specially the women. The survey showed that although digitalization had started making inroads into the lives of people yet a long way had to be gone before making it really successful.

Evening session of the camp witnessed experience sharing of the students from different faculties of the university regarding the relevance of the subjects taught to them and when actually put into practice. Gurbaksh and Yuvraj along with others took a lead in this. The volunteers after closing the day at village Barna with singing of National Anthem, the practice followed throughout the camp, returned to university. After having dinner the volunteers went into sharing their experience of the day with other residents of the hostels and acquainted them of the hardships being faced in the rural India.

Day 3 (23/03/2018) :-

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The third day of the camp again started with yoga where Prof. D.S. Rana, Coordinator NSS Cell, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, paid a visit and highly appreciated the devotion and sentiment of social service being demonstrated by the volunteers and the Programme Officers.

It being Shahidi Diwas before leaving for Barna, the volunteers paid their respect and tribute at the statue of Shri. Bhagat Singh installed opposite university market. Dr. Neeraj Batish, Programme Officer, in a short address highlighted the

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role of freedom fighters and the sacrifices made by them because of which we now

are able to enjoy a dignified and comfortable life. The day at the village started with the usual practice of NSS Song and reading of the report which followed throughout the camp. First Aid and Home Nursing Training by the District Youth Red Cross was also initiated on the third day which was spread throughout the camp. In the afternoon session all the volunteers participated in slogan writing and poster making competition on the theme 'Communal Harmony.' Prof. D.S. Rana was the Chief Guest during the competition; he applauded and encouraged the volunteers with sharing of his healthy and rich experience. After that the routine schedule as reported earlier was practiced both at Barna and the university campus.

Day 4 (24/03/2018) :-

After practicing Yoga and daily morning schedule the volunteers reached Barna at 9:30 a.m. 'Duties of an NSS Volunteer and the Expectations of the Society' was the topic on which Dr. Neeraj Batish gave a detailed talk while Dr. Raj Kamal shared his views on 'Importance of Moral Values among Youth.' This was followed by a rally carried out by the volunteers on the theme 'Communal Harmony' in the village. After the rally the volunteers divided into various groups had an interaction with the villagers where they highlighted the importance of a peaceful and harmonious life. Communal Harmony stickers and badge were also distributed in the village.

Later Gurbaksh, Amit, Khushbu, Rashmi Battan, Abhishek, Naveen, Akhilesh, among others shared their views on the topics like Mutual Funds, Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, Water Harvesting, River Saraswati, Sustainable Development and the recent important judgments pronounced by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. These discussions were attended by many villagers as well. All work and no play makes Jack a dull boy. Hence a session for cultural activies was also kept for the day where Pankaj, Arvind, Rohit Pannu, Amit Sangwan showcased their talent.

Day 5 (25/03/2018) :-

Prof. CDS Kaushal, Director, Youth and Cultural Affairs, KUK and a former Coordinator, NSS Cell, KUK and Indira Gandhi Awardee highlighted the role of the spirit of service in his address. He also expressed his concern on the decreasing use of Sanskrit in day to day life.

Prof. (Retd.) Himmat Singh Sinha, Department of Philosophy, KUK and an eminent speaker gave a rich talk on the importance of self-confidence and character building among youth.

Day 6 (26/03/2018) :-

A Blood Donation camp was organized at LNJP hospital Kurukshetra on the sixth day of the camp where twenty units of blood were donated by the volunteers. In the evening session Dr. Amit Kumar and Dr. Sant Lal, Institute of Law, Kurukshetra University addressed the students and shared their views on the topics 'Significance of Rights and Duties' and 'Role of Youth in Development' respectively. Both the addresses were highly appreciated by the volunteers.

Ms. Harsha and Mr. Rohit Pannu, who had represented the UTD NSS at Republic Day Parade, Raj Path, New Delhi, shared their experiences and encouraged their other fellow volunteers to do put in maximum efforts in order to achieve that platform.

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Day 7 (27/03/2018) :-

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The morning session of the last day of the camp again witnessed the interaction of the volunteers with the villagers. Communal Harmony stickers and badges were distributed throughout the village and a word of thankfulness and appreciation for being such a helpful host was spread. The volunteers appealed the villagers to sustain the spirit of communal harmony amongst them. The villagers too reciprocated with a very warm heart and extended the invitation for next time as well.

Shri Devi Dayal, Chairman, Block Samiti was the Chief Guest while Sri. Shiv Kumar, Sarpanch was the Guest of Honour at the Valedictory function which took place at 3:00 p.m. in the village anganwadi. The guests highly appreciated the gesture of the NSS volunteers and expressed hope in the bright future of India. The function included a host of patriotic cultural items which mesmerized the villagers. The Seven Day Special Camp concluded with singing of the NSS Song followed by National Anthem.



4. Blood Donation Camp:




First Aid and Home Nursing Training-




LEGAL AID AS AN INSTRUMENT OF SOCIAL JUSTICE

INSTITUTE OF LAW

INSTITUTE OF LAW



The Institute of Law, Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra, has the unique distinction of being the first law school in Haryana to start a five-year integrated B.A.LL.B (Hans.) Program in 2001 and it has now entered its 19ⁿ year of imparting excellence in legal education. The Institute provides excellent platform for the study of law in a dynamic environment. It has been ranked the seventeenth best Law Institute in India by India Today-Nielsen Survey in 2018. Set up in the holy city of Kurukshetra the Institute of law aims to develop in the students' social and scientific research skills so as to enhance in them a sense of responsibility to serve the society as professionals.

The curriculum of the Institute is designed to inculcate in the students professional skills of advocacy. The skills so imported here are integrated with conceptual and theoretical foundations of a vast range of legal and social science streams taught by a dedicated pool of teachers pursuing academic excellence. The Institute of Law has emerged as one of the pacesetters in the Indian legal education.

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LEGAL AID CELL

In the Plan of Action for the year 2009-10 sent by Member Secretary, National Legal Services Authority through Haryana State Legal Services Authority vide letter no. 6185-6194/2009/MS/HSLSA dated 14.5.2009, the Authority requested to setup Legal Aid Clinics in all the Law Calleges and Universities and to encourage students to adopt remote wilage areas as their area of operation. Institute of Law, Rurukshetra University has established a Legal Aid Clinic in association with Haryana State Legal Services Authority and District Legal Services Authority, Kurukshetra in compliance with such plan of action. Now, in the 10° year of its establishment, the Legal Aid Cell is working in very effective

The Legal Aid Cell, under the guidance of Worthy Director, is headed by the Faculty Convener and assisted by the Student Coordinator. A committee of faculty members and a team of energetic and dedicated legal aid volunteers (students) work for the Legal Aid Cell.

The avawed purpose of the cell is to promote access to the legal system, whereby every person has access to the legal process irrespective of social or economic incapacity. The cell endeavors to sensitized students to the problems faced by the common men and to inculcate a sense of social responsibility in the students. Further, the cell is meant to act as a platform for introducing the students to functioning of the legal system. The legal aid initiative has been fashioned not as a mere means of aiding litigation, but as an autreach program directed at community welfare. Since a majority of our fellow countrymen do not enjoy easy access to the legal services, the cell seeks to address this problem by dispensing free legal and paralegal service.

The Legal Aid Cell seeks to -

- Assist the general public in better interpretation of the rights bestowed apon them and spread awareness on socio-legal issues.
- Play a constructive rale in counseling people opting for legal recourse.
- To encourage pre-fitigation services and alternate dispute resolution mechanisms and settlements.
- To serve as a potent platform where our youth is inducted in developmental initiatives and programs for serving the society.

LEGAL PROVISIONS

"Directive Principles have been regarded as soul of the Constitution as India is a welfare state. They provide for guidance to interpretation of Fundamental rights of the citizens as also statutory rights."

Charu Khurana v. Union of India AIR 2015, SC 839.

Part IV, Article 39A of the Constitution of India, instituted by Constitution (42" Amendment) Act, 1976 provides for the concept 'EQUAL JUSTICE AND FREE LEGAL AID' – the State shall secure that the operations of the legal system promote justice, on the basis of equal opportunity, and shall, in particular, provide free legal aid, by suitable legislation or schemes or in any other way, to ensure that opportunities for securing justice are not denied to any citizens by reason of economic or other disabilities.

Thus, Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 was enacted to constitute legal services authorities for providing free and competent legal services to the weaker section of the society. Various other regulations are notified timely by the Government of India. One such important regulation is National Legal Services Authority (Legal Aid Clinics) Regulations 2011 notified on 10^e Aug 2011 by the Government of India.



Legal Aid Comps

The Legal Ald Cell has been since its very inception organizing legal literacy and legal old camps in various parts of District Kurukshetra. While traditionally legal old tackled only the poorest and most marginalized our policy has been to provide legal aid to those who need it the most. This would mean while we do focus on those most in need, we do not ignore the concerns of the better of persons as regards specific issues such as consumer protection and the right to information. The Legal Aid Cell, at various levels, organize legal literacy camps largely in rural and socio-economically backward areas, schools, colleges and local community centers to inform the citizens about their legal rights, legal institutions and socialwelfare legislation which are meant for their economic and social benefit. The Legal Aid Cell has organized 56 such events including participation in Rural Lok Adolots and Comps for creating awareness among masses. On an average, the Legal Aid Cell organizes 2-3 camps in an academic year.

Total 32 students were selected as Para Legal Volunteers for year 2018. (23 November 2017 to 22 November 2018)


The tenure of these 32 Para Legal Valunteers has been extended till further orders for year 2019. (23 November 2018 - till further)













