#### **INFORMATION BROCHURE**

#### 1. Reception

- Participating teams shall intimate or report to the Secretary about the date and time of their arrival, well in advance.
- Kurukshetra is at a distance of about 160 Kms. from Delhi, on Delhi-Panipat-Karnal Ambala route on the Northern Railway. It is about 35 Kms. from Ambala towards Karnal. A good number of trains (Mail as well as passenger) run from New Delhi to Amritsar/JammuTawi/Ambala, and Kurukshetra is on this route. Teams coming by Bus can alight at Pipli Bus Stand, which is just 08 Kms. from Kurukshetra University. Frequent local Bus service and Auto Rickshaws from Pipli are available from early morning till late night.

#### 2. Accomodation

Teams will be provided free unfurnished rooms type of accommodation near the University Campus in Dharamshala(s). Teams are requested to bring their own Locks & Keys for their own safety. Accommodation will be provided only 24 hours prior to the commencement of the matches and the same is required to be vacated immediately if they fail to quality for the next round.

- ✓ Accommodation counter will be arranged at Kurukshetra University. All the team managers are requested to contact Sh. Ramesh Chand -9416833605 & Sh. Rajesh Kumar - 9354920309 the accommodation in-charges at the tournament venue.
- ✓ Each team will have to pay Rs. 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Only) as caution deposit, which will be refunded at the time of departure of the team after adjusting to the cost of damages.

### 3. Manager's Meeting

The meeting of the Managers will be held on 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2023 at 04:00 PM in the University Campus. All team managers are requested to be present.

### 4. Eligibility & Documents

The team Managers are requested to bring with them 04 Copies of Eligibility proforma (Latest Proforma with Aadhar Number of the Players) duly typed and signed by the Registrar / Director of Physical Education / Sports officer of the participating University, sports Identity Card, DMC of Matric and 10+2 (in case of under Graduate classes) and that of Matric, 10+2 and Graduation (in case of P.G. classes) & a copy of subscription receipt obtained from AIU New Delhi. The teams must also bring with them the Online Generated receipt of AIU Registration Fee @ Rs. 3,000/- per Team. The link for submitting online Fee is <a href="https://payment.aiu.ac.in">https://payment.aiu.ac.in</a> The manual for generating online is also attached.

## 5. Officiating Charges

- ✓ The Manager of every team should pay Rs. 1500/- (Rupees One thousand Five Hundred Only) per match as Officiating charges to the organizing Secretary / Ground In-charge officers before the commencement of their match.
- ✓ An amount of Rs.1000/- (Rupees one Thousand Only) will be collected towards the match ball. The ball will be supplied by the organizing committee. No other ball will be allowed in the tournament.
- Matches will be held on matting and turf as per the availability of grounds. Hence the teams are advised to play accordingly.
- The teams should be ready Forty five minutes before the Commencement of their matches.
- The Managers / Coach will be requested to produce the ball receipt whenever asked by the umpire.

### 6. Competition Rule

- ✓ All matches will be played as per the International Cricket Council as adapted by Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi.
- ✓ The team Managers are requested to follow the match schedule strictly and arrange to report to their teams at least 30 minutes before the commencement of the match.
- ✓ The organizing Secretary reserves the right to make any changes in the programs and the venue, if necessary, which shall be final and binding on the participant teams.
- ✓ A copy of the fixtures is enclosed.
- ✓ The team Managers, Coaches and players are requested to cooperate with the Organizing Secretary/Organizers/Match Officials for the smooth conduct of the tournament.
- ✓ Protest against any other nature in connection with conduct of sporting competitions shall be in writing and must reach the organizing secretary along with protest fee Rs.2000/- only within "Two Hours' of the conclusion of the concerned matches for consideration of the "Jury of Appeal" for an appropriate necessary action, then and there/on the spot, in this regard.

## 7. PLAYING CONDITION-25 OVERS-UPTO QUARTER FINALS

- ✓ All matches are played on Knock-out Basis.
- ✓ A player should be in proper cricketing attire (White clothing & predominantly white shoes unless specified otherwise). The umpires are the sole authority in implementing the dress code. The Umpires shall ask the concerned player to leave the field if the dress code is not followed.
- $\checkmark$  On matting wickets use of spiked shoes by the bowlers and batsman is not permitted.
- ✓ All matches will be of one innings per side, each innings being limited to 25 Overs per side. Minimum 10 overs constitute a match in case of any interrupted matches.
- ✓ Declaration is not permitted.
- ✓ No bowler shall bowl more than 05 overs in an innings. In a delayed or interrupted match where the overs are reduced for both teams or for the team bowling second, no bowler may bowl more than one-fifth of the total overs allowed. Where the total overs are not divisible by 05, one additional over shall be allowed to the maximum number per bowler necessary to make up the balance.
- Free hit will be awarded forall types of No Balls. During free hit, chance of field/fieldman is not permitted for the same striker.
- At the instant of delivery, there shall not be more than 5 field men outside the inner circle throughout the match.

- A bowler shall be limited to One fast short-pitched delivery per over. Subsequent short pitch deliveries in the same over shall be called No Ball

## 8. RESULT-25 OVERS-UPTO QUARTER FINALS

- Once the match begins and a team does not continue with the it shall be considered as conceding the match.
- ✓ Absenting a team or only certain number of players present and not filling the nomination form is considered as "Walk Over".
- ✓ When the match is called off without a ball being bowled and even minimum 10 overs for both the sides is not achieved the result will be decided by "SPIN OF COIN" by the captains in the presence of umpires.
- ✓ In case of a tie, the team which has lost a lesser number of wickets will be declared as the winner.
- In case of equality in the number of wickets lost, the result will decided by "SPIN COIN" by the captains in presence of the umpires.
- ✓ In case of team batting second has the opportunity of playing 10 overs or more and is interrupted due to ground, weather and light conditions the result of the match is decided with the team having better run rate at that stage. (For Ex. If team A has scored 150 runs in allotted 25 overs (NRR=6.00), Team B had scored 100 runs in 20 overs (NRR=5.00). Team A wins the match by better Run rate.
- Umpire's decision will B final and binding. No appeal/protest against the umpire's decision are entertained.

#### 9. PLAYING CONDITION-40 OVERS

- ✓ All Matches are played on Knockout Basis.
- ✓ A player should be in proper cricketing attire (white clothing & predominantly white shoes unless specified otherwise). The umpires are the sole authority in implementing the dress code. The Umpires shall ask the concerned player to leave the field if the dress code is not permitted.
- ✓ On matting wickets use of spiked shoes by the bowlers and batsman is not permitted.
- ✓ All matches will be of one innings per sdide, each innings being limited to 40 Overs per side. Minimum 10 overs constitute a match in case of any interrupted matches.
- ✓ Declaration is not permitted.
- ✓ No bowler shall bowl more than 08 overs in an innings. In a delayed or interrupted match where the overs are reduced for both teams or for the team bowling second, no bowler may bowl more than one-fifth of the total overs allowed. Where the total overs are not divisible by 5, one additional over shall be allowed to the maximum number per bowler necessary to make up the balance.
- Free hit will be awarded for all types of No Balls. During Free hit, change of field/fieldman is not permitted for the same striker.
- √ Field placement during power play will be as under:

- 01 to 08 overs -- 02 fielders outside the inner circle
- 09 to 32 overs 04 fielders outside the inner circle
- 33 to 40 overs 05 fielders outside the inner circle
- ✓ If the number of overs are reduced for the match, power play overs will be accordingly reduced by the umpires and will be informed to both captains at the toss.
- ✓ A bowler shall be limited Two fast short-pitched delivery per over. Subsequent short pitch deliveries in the same over shall be called No Ball

#### 10. RESULT

- Once the match beings and a team does not continue with the match it shall be considered conceding the match.
- ✓ Absenting a team or only a certain number of players present and not filling the nomination form is considered as "Walk over".
- ✓ When the match is called off without a ball being bowled and even minimum 15 overs for both sides is not achieved the result will be decided by "SPIN OF COIN" by the captains in the presence of umpires.
- ✓ In case of a tie, the team which has lost, the result will be decided by "SPIN OF COIN" by the captains in presence of the umpires.
- ✓ In case the team batting second has the opportunity of playing 10 overs or more and is interrupted due to ground, weather and light conditions the result of the match is decided with the team having better net run rate at that stage. (For Ex. If team A has scored 270 runs in allotted 45 overs (NRR=6.00), Team B had scored 150 runs in 30 overs(NRR=5.00). team A wins the match by better Run rate.
- ✓ Umpire's decision will be final and binding. No appeal/protest against the umpire's decision are entertained.
