Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra-136119, Haryana
AND
Dr. Y.S. Parmar University of Horticulture & Forestry, Nauni
Solon-173 230, HP

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into on this 14th day of August, 2014 between Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra - 136 119 (hereinafter referred to as KUK) represented by its Registrar having its office at Kurukshetra, Haryana and Dr. Y.S. Parmar University of Horticulture & Forestry, Nauni, Solon - 173 230, HP (hereinafter referred to as UHF) represented by Director of Research having its office at Nauni, Tehsil and District Solon, HP.

Sharing a common desire to explore, extend and strengthen the functional relationship between the Universities and National Scientific Institutes/Laboratories of Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra and Dr. Y.S. Parmar University of Horticulture & Forestry herewith agreed to sign memorandum of understanding for sharing the facilities and expertise available in each other institutions with the following terms and conditions :-

1. This MoU shall come into force with immediate effect and will remain valid for a period of five years at first instance, which may be extended with the consent of both the parties.
2. The MoU shall be deemed to have been automatically rescinded after the expiry of the MoU period, unless renewed. Steps for the renewal shall be taken at least three months in advance before the expiry date.
3. Students desiring to undertake research work at KUK/UHF will have to get the application recommended from their respective institutes.
4. The student desiring to work at KUK/UHF will have to select problem/area of research as per the mandate of KUK/UHF.
5. The student in consultation with Major Advisor/Supervisor and Co-Advisor/Co-Supervisor can carry out their research work partly at KUK and partly at UHF depending upon facilities available at the place.
6. The students who will register for research programme with KUK and UHF shall pay University fee as per parent University norms from time to time.
7. All credits and benefits of collaborative work including the intellectual property generated during the tenancy of project would be equally shared between both parties i.e. both parties shall be the joint owners of this intellectual property.

8. The collaborative programme between two parties shall be coordinated by a *Coordination Committee* consisting of one member from each organization appointed by competent authorities of KUK and UHF, respectively.
9. The decision regarding patenting of the technology developed shall be taken jointly by the *Coordination Committee*. In case the technology developed is to be patented, the cost of patent and benefits occurred shall be shared as per guidelines of the KUK and UHF. Rights for the commercialization shall rest jointly with both the parties and shall be decided by the *Coordination Committee*. In case of involvement of private sector, decision will be taken through joint consultations and keeping in view the guidelines of the KUK/UHF.
10. Either of the parties hereto shall be entitled to terminate the MoU at any time with valid reasons acceptable in writing to both the parties and in such case, the MoU will terminate six months after the date of written notification or date of expiry of the MoU, whichever is earlier. In case of such premature termination of the MoU, all rights and obligations of both the parties shall automatically cease except for those covered by written contract including ongoing collaborative activity that can no longer be cancelled till it is completed.
11. In case of any dispute that may crop up during execution of MoU, the matter would be settled through arbitration by referring to *Arbitration Committee* comprising of a member nominated each by two parties and one member jointly nominated by two parties.


