DAY 1



Proposal to organize Research Methodology Workshop from 02nd August to 07th August, 2021.

Department of Commerce, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra proposes to organize one-week Workshop on Research Methodology, focusing on Questionnaire Development and Structural Equation Modelling from August 2, 2021 to August 7, 2021. 
