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### **KURUKSHETRA UNIVERSITY, KURUKSHETRA**

Agenda for the 125<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Academic Council of the Kurukshetra to be held on Wednesday, the 19th July, 2023 at 03:30 p.m. in the Senate Hall, Shrimad Bhagvadgita Sadan, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra.

#### STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

As per Clause 8.3 of the Ordinance for M.A. Economics (Final) Examinations, appearing at page 328 of K.U. Calendar Vol.-II Part-B 2014, a candidate who fails to pass M.A. Economics Examination within a period of four years of his/her admission to the course shall be deemed to be unfit for the course.

In the instant case Ms. Neha Makkar took admission in M.A. Economics (Previous) first time during the session (2018-19) but could not complete the course within stipulated period i.e. 2021-22. Now she has requested to allow her M.A. Economics (Final) in the Directorate to complete her M.A. Economics degree course during the session July, 2022. The Vice-Chancellor in anticipation of the approval of the Academic Council allowed admission to her in M.A. Economics (Final) through DDE as a special case with extra fee of Rs. 7000/- in addition to normal fee/late fee etc.

The Academic Council has already allowed admission to some candidates also to complete their degree course as a special case on one or the other grounds with the penalty of Rs. 7000/- in addition to normal fee/dues for permitting them extension of **One year** beyond four years which is the stipulated period for passing M.A./M.Sc. degree course.

As per Clause 6.3 of the Ordinance for M.A. History (Final) Examinations, appearing at page 356 of K.U. Calendar Vol-II, Part-B 2014, a candidate who fails to pass M.A. History Examination within a period of four years of his/her admission to the course shall be deemed to be unfit for the course.

In the instant case Mr. Vikram Jeet took admission in M.A. History (Previous) first time during the session 2018-19 but could not complete the course within stipulated period i.e. 2021-22. Now he has requested to allow him to take admission in M.A. History (Final) in the Directorate to complete his masters' degree during the session January, 2023. The Vice-Chancellor in anticipation of the approval of the Academic Council allowed admission to him in M.A. History (Final) through DDE as a special case with extra fee of Rs. 7000/- in addition to normal fee/late fee etc.

The Academic Council has already allowed admission to some candidates also to complete their degree courses as a special case on one or the other grounds with the penalty of Rs. 7,000/- in addition to normal fee/dues for permitting them extension of One year beyond four years which is the stipulated period for passing M.A./M.Sc. degree course.

## Existing

## Clause 11.11 of Ph.D. Ordinance

In case, a Research Scholar fails in the Ph.D. coursework, he/she shall be given only one more chance to appear in the re-examination of Ph.D. coursework which shall be held after a gap of 3 months from the date of declaration of the result of Ph.D. coursework. In case, if a Research Scholar fails to qualify again in the re-examination, his/her admission shall stand automatically cancelled. A candidate failing to attend coursework will have to seek admission afresh.

#### Recommended

#### Clause 11.11 of Ph.D. Ordinance

In case, a Research Scholar fails in the Ph.D. coursework, he/she shall be given only one more chance to appear in the re-examination of Ph.D. coursework which shall be held after a gap of 3 (three) months from the date of declaration of the result of Ph.D. coursework. In case, if a Research Scholar fails to qualify again in the re-examination, his/her admission shall stand automatically cancelled. A candidate failing to attend coursework will have to seek admission afresh.

However, Research Scholar may apply for re-evaluation of the coursework paper to the Chairperson of the concerned department. Re-evaluation will be done at the level of department. However re-evaluation can be done by outside faculty also if needed with the approval of the competent authority. The fee for re-evaluation shall be Rs.500/- per paper. The Research Scholar may apply for re-evaluation to the Chairperson of the department alongwith fee within 20 days from the date of communication of Ph.D. coursework result to the student by the Department after that no re-evaluation will be allowed.

#### STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The complaint received from Mr. Nardev, Research Scholar, Department of Ancient Indian History, Cultural and Archaeology regarding Ph.D. coursework result was placed before the Dean's Committee constituted by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor consisting of Dean Academic Affairs, Dean R&D and all Faculty Dean's. The Committee after detailed deliberations recommended amendments to clause 11.11 of the Ph.D. Ordinance (Annexure Pages 6(1)).

#### STATEMENT OF THE CASE:-

A meeting of the Committee made the following recommendations after detailed discussion on the instructions/guidelines dated September 4, 2020 issued by the UGC, New Delhi:-

- 1. Ratio of **Internal & External Assessment** Committee perused clause 15(A) 3 of UGC guidelines that provides for maximum 30 % formative assessment and minimum 70% summative assessment. Director, Directorate of Distance Education, explained the need of emphasis on formative assessment in view of NEP-2020 and informed the Committee that 30:70 format has already been adopted for online programmes of Directorate of Distance Education. Considering all aspects, the Committee recommended that the same i.e. 30:70 ratio of Internal and External Assessment may also be adopted for all the courses run through ODL mode **in place of existing 20:80.**
- 2. Committee perused Clause 2(x) and Table 1 on Page-98 of UGC (ODL Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020. The Committee is of opinion that there is a need for reformatting or renaming all PG Diploma Programmes. It recommended that all one year PG Diploma Programmes may be renamed as Advanced Graduate Diploma except PG Diploma in Computer Applications (PGDCA) run through ODL mode. As PGDCA is an integrated programme with M.Sc. and MCA, it was resolved that Chairperson, Department of Computer Science & Applications may provide a suitable format for this.
- 3. Mobility of ODL/Online with regular programmes. Committee perused clause 22 & 23 of UGC (ODL Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 in this regard and the Committee also noted the existing rules as mentioned in the ordinance of DDE at Point No.16 (i) Any regular student of such a Course in the University Teaching Department/College as is available in the Directorate who has been detained for want of fulfilment of the eligibility conditions of attendance/house test, etc. for appearing in the annual examination as a regular student of that College/Department but is otherwise eligible for admission to the course through distance education may be allowed admission to the same Course in the Directorate ordinarily upto such time as may be prescribed in the Prospectus of the Directorate After detailed discussion the Committee from time to time..... recommends that ODL/Online students may be provided mobility to regular programmes after 1st year in odd semester only within the Higher Education

Institution provided the programmes under consideration fulfill the requirements of Clause 4 on page 70 of UGC guidelines. Reproduced as under:

"(4) A Higher Educational Institution other than an Open Universities shall offer programmes in Open and Distance Learning mode and/or Online mode with total credits and minimum duration for the programmes kept same as that of corresponding programmes in conventional mode."

For the programmes under the domain of regulatory authority, prior permission from concerned authority could be needed for such mobility.

For implementation of above said points (1 to 3) these proceeding may be placed before the Ad-hoc Committee of the Directorate of Distance Education (Acting as Board of Studies). The concerned Departments may also be requested to make necessary amendments in the programmes and respective ordinances in their Board of Studies.
