MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

between

Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra

and

Swadeshi Swavlamban Nyas

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered on 01.02.2023

Between

Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, hereinafter referred to as the "KUK" or the "FIRST PARTY"

and

Swadeshi Swavlamban Nyas, GT Road, Panipat, hereinafter referred to as the "SSN" or the "SECOND PARTY"

The "SSN" and "KUK" are hereinafter, collectively referred to as the "PARTIES" and individually as "PARTY"

WHEREAS

India at present is the youngest nation in the world with about 37 crore youth within the age group of 15-29 years. It is known as our demographic dividend. We can achieve higher milestones of progress if the power of our youth is properly utilized. However, it is experienced that we are not able to provide employment/jobs to all the youth. Unemployment at the moment is one of the main problems of our country. It is estimated that 7-9% of youth are unemployed, and in higher education unemployment is even more severe.

It is a known fact that Govt. jobs are only about 2% and corporate sector jobs are also only 5-6%. The casual/contract work type jobs are 15-20% where average salary is less than ten thousand rupee per month. Rest of the employment comes from agriculture sector (about 50%) and from MSME (Micro Small Medium Enterprises) sector. It is clear that self-employment is the main source of employment in Haryana and rest of the country. Providing skilling and entrepreneurship training to the students can inspire them to go for self-employment and help to overcome the problem of unemployment.

There are various Govt. schemes available for skilling, entrepreneurship and employment generation through various departments of the Government and many of the schemes offer high subsidies and incentives to the youth on starting their own enterprises. However, it is experienced that most of the students/youth are not aware of these schemes of government.

The parties of this Memorandum of understanding will collaborate to provide the skilling and entrepreneurship training to the students in the State of Haryana and help them also avail benefits of various government schemes.

Through this MoU it is intended to achieve the following objectives:

- (i) Motivate and inspire the students to be the job providers rather than job seekers.
- (ii) Bring awareness among the students about the benefits of self-employment/entrepreneurship.
- (iii) Facilitate the students to have proper exposure to industry/market by internship/training.
- (iv) Give them first hand feel of entrepreneurship by arranging interactive sessions with successful entrepreneurs.
- (v) Help the students to incubate their ideas through incubation centers of the Universities/Colleges by providing mentors from the industry/relevant field and help them to start their star-ups.
- (vi) Provide information to the students about various schemes of the Govt. so as to enable them avail various loans and subsidies for their enterprises.
- (vii) Help the students to get good placement in industry/other sectors by providing proper skill training.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MoU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Swadeshi Swavlamban Nyas will provide experts for motivating the students towards self-employment and entrepreneurship and undertake various skill programmes. It will also help in giving training to the master trainers/coordinators for further dissemination to the level of all students.
- 1.2 Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra will set up Rojgar Srijan Kendra to achieve the objectives of this MoU.
- 1.3 Kurukshetra University will facilitate/arrange programmes/talks/skilling courses as its core and extension activities.
- 1.4 Swadeshi Swavlamban Nyas will provide trained coordinators for Rojgar Srijan Kendra.
- 1.5 The Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they will establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to availing benefits of Govt. schemes, skill development, providing training of entrepreneurship to the students of KUK and other Educational Institutions as per need.
- 1.6 The Parties co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the Experts of both Parties providing significant inputs to them in inspiring the

students and in developing suitable skill training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the students.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.1 To enhance skills and knowledge of students and youths of state to get better employment/jobs and entrepreneurship skills.
- 2.2 To give valuable inputs/guidance through various programmes/talks/skill training methodology to the Master Trainers as well as to the students for better training & employment/placement of students of Educational Institutions of Haryana.
- 2.3 To arrange visits of the Experts and Representatives in Educational Institutions for Skill Training Programs for the students. The skill training and exposure provided to students and faculty will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career and to motivate and inspire the students to be the **job providers rather than job seekers** by enhancing their own family enterprises or start a new enterprise/start-up on a fresh idea in areas of their interest and choice.
- 2.4 To train the students of KUK and other Educational Institutions on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gaps and make them employment/industry ready.
- 2.5 Both parties will actively engage to help the delivery of the Internship, Entrepreneurship, skilling and placement of students of the Higher Education Institutions by providing Coordinators/Master Trainers/required facilities for this purpose.
- 2.6 The financial commitment on the part of the parties towards each other, to take up any activity mentioned in the MoU will be dealt separately through mutual consent.

CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 3.1 Nothing contained in this MoU shall, by express grant, implication, estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid initially for a period of 5 years. It can be extended further with mutual consent.
- 4.2 All Parties may terminate this MoU upon 3 (Three) months' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, all parties have to discharge their existing obligations.


CLAUSE 5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

This non-binding memorandum of understanding is signed on 02 day of January 2023 between

Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra having its headquarters at Kurukshetra (Haryana)-136119, India, through its Institute of Integrated & Honors Studies (hereinafter called IIHS-KUK) include his/her successor in office, legal representative, nominee and assignee as the **First Party**.

AND

Yushu Excellence Technologies Pvt. Ltd. Operating office, Incubation Centrer, BITS PILANI, Pilani Campus represented through Dr. Amit Dua (Co-founder and CEO) hereinafter referred to as Yushu (which expression shall, unless it is repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean and include their other administrators, successors in business, and permitted assigns) of the **OTHER PARTY**.

WHEREAS

The parties wish to establish a friendly relationship to promote and accelerate the academic cooperation and have decided to enter into this MoU and agree hereby as per articles given below

1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1. DEFINITIONS --“KUK” means Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra.

1.1.1. “IIHS-KUK” means Institute of Integrated Honors Studies, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra.

1.1.2. “Yushu” means Yushu Excellence Technologies Pvt. Ltd.

1.2. RELATION BETWEEN THE PARTIES AND SCOPE

Yushu Excellence Technologies Pvt. Ltd. undertakes to impart trainings and conduct internships to the students of Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, specifically of the Institute of Integrated & Honors Studies

1.2.1. The training program will be of 30 hours over 4 months for 2 credits per week and internship will be for 8-10 weeks for 10 credits as per Kurukshetra University rules.

1.2.2. Yushu Excellence Technologies Pvt. Ltd will conduct internship programs, training sessions, workshops, seminars, series of practical assignments etc. through their engineers, trainers, developers etc., so that-

a) Students can understand the concepts and the software developments in Block chain Technology

b) Students of the university can acquire knowledge of the tools (products) of Yushu, which are used to create solutions and improve the performance of various organizations.

c) Students can experience the problems solved using Block chain Technology and how Yushu uses industrial practices and tools to rectify these problems.

d) Students can learn product development lifecycle to solve complex network problems.

1.3. The classes and assessment may be conducted online or offline by mutual understanding of both Parties.

1.4. Yushu Support

- 1.4.1. Shall be responsible for conducting the classes as per curriculum and also be responsible for counseling of students.
- 1.4.2. Shall not use classroom platform for any other purpose than conduct internship programs, and training sessions.
- 1.4.3. Shall bear all expenses incurred on conducting the said program and KUK shall bear no cost for the same.
- 1.4.4. Shall conduct the assessment of the candidates.

1.5. IIHS-KUK

- 1.5.1. Shall decide eligibility criteria for the admission of the said course.
- 1.5.2. Shall prepare the syllabus of the said course in consultation with Yushu and get the same approved by its competent authorities.
- 1.5.3. Shall guide Yushu to undertake all the academic activities including conduct of assessment leading to completion of the course.
- 1.5.4. Boarding and lodging facilities for engineers, trainers, and developers of Yushu who will visit the University to conduct internship program training sessions, workshop seminars, series of practical assignments, etc.
- 1.5.5. Facility to use the available resources to conduct internship programs, training session workshops, seminars, series of practical assignments, etc. for the students for Yushu.
- 1.5.6. There shall not be any financial liability on either party.

1.6. MANAGEMENT, GOVERNING LAW & JURISDICTION

1.6.1. MANAGEMENT

The Principal IIHS, KUK and CEO, Yushu will be responsible to work out operational details of co-operation between the two entities and ensure proper and effective implementation of this MoU.

1.6.2. GOVERNING LAW & JURISDICTION

This MoU has been executed in English language, which shall be the binding and controlling language for all matters related to the meaning of interpretation of this MoU.

This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. Any dispute arising under these terms and conditions shall be subjected to the jurisdiction of the courts of Kurukshetra (Haryana)

1.7. LOCATION

1.7.1. Course implementation arising under this MoU shall be performed by both the parties from their head offices

1.8. AUTHORISED REPRESENTATIVES

1.8.1. Any action required or permitted to be taken and any document required or permitted to be executed under this MoU may be taken or executed.

- a). On behalf of the First Party, by the Registrar/ competent authority, KUK
- b). On behalf of the second Party, by the CEO/competent authority, Yushu

2. COMMENCEMENT, COMPLETION, MODIFICATION AND TERMINATION OF THIS MoU

- 2.1. This MoU shall come into force from the date of signing.
- 2.2. This MoU shall be effective for a period of five years, but will be reviewed/renewed/modified(if needed) mutually by both the parties.
- 2.3. This MoU may be modified/amended by mutual written agreement at any time by either party upon written notification signed by the competent authority of the party.
- 2.4. The modification/changes shall become part of the MoU and shall be effective from the date on which they are made/executed, unless otherwise agreed to.
- 2.5. The MoU may be terminated prematurely by either party with mutual agreement by giving prior notice. Such notification must be given to the other party at least three months in advance from the effective date of termination.
- 2.6. All joint activities not completed at the expiration of termination of the MoU may be continued until their completion under the terms of this MoU shall come into force from the date of signing.







3. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into on 27-01-2023 by and between the Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra (India) and Association of Haryanvis in Australia (AHA), Level-6, 93 George Street, Parramatta, NSW, 2150.

Kurukshetra University referred to as KUK hereafter is the first party to this agreement. It is a multidisciplinary NAAC accredited A+ University that was established in 1956. The University offers large number of graduate, post-graduate and research based programmes in traditional and new subjects and in both the online and offline modes. It provides high quality learning experience through a blend of class room and field based teaching. Apart to academic upliftment of the students, the University organizes various cultural activities/programmes/seminars to connect the young generation with rich cultural heritage of our State and traditions of our country.

Association of Haryanvis in Australia referred to as AHA hereafter is the second party to this agreement. The association is working in Australia to promote the rich Haryanvi heritage, culture and its integration with multicultural Australia whilst promoting camaraderie and a sense of belonging amongst fellow Haryanvis. AHA has been doing the tremendous work in not only connecting the Haryanvi Diaspora across Australia but also assisting the locals in Australia as well as Haryanvi fraternity in India.

Articles 1-Objectives of collaboration

The areas of cooperation may include, subject to mutual consent, any desirable and feasible activity that would further the goals of each institution subject to compliance of rules of collaboration in each country. The anticipated cooperation in various academic and cultural activities is:

- Promotion of Haryanvi Culture through Cultural Exchange programmes.
- Exhibition of Folk Art of Haryana in different cities of Australia.
- Seminars on Folk Culture and Haryanvi Language in Australia.

- Academic Work and Literary Seminars in Australia and India.
- Assigning the Projects by AHA to DYCA for revival of various dying arts of Haryana.
- Organization of online Dance/Literary/Music workshops for the residents of Australia.
- AHA will provide the opportunities to the willing students of KUK for placement in Australia in different fields.
- Joint conferences and workshops;
- Visits by faculty, professionals, staff, and students.

However, neither party is obligated to agree to any minimum number of activities, nor is this MOU intended to preclude either party from entering into similar agreements with other institutions.

Article 2- Scope of MOU

This MOU shall act as the parent document and further agreements concerning other activities shall provide details of commitments therein in writing under the signatures of duly authorized representatives of the parties.

Article 3- Responsibilities of home and host institution for academic and cultural exchanges

- KUK will provide cultural exchange and training opportunities to the students recommended through AHA.
- AHA will offer immersion activities to students/party members recommended by KUK.
- AHA will provide the opportunities to the willing students of KUK for placement in Australia in different fields.

Article 4 Nondiscrimination

KUK and AHA agree not to discriminate against any person because of age, sex, national origin, race, ancestry, color, religious, creed disability and sexual orientation. Neither institution shall impose criteria for the exchange of faculty, staff and students that would violate the principles of non-discrimination.

Article 5- Code of Conduct

Visiting student, faculty and other staff will abide by the codes of conduct of the host Institution.

Article 6- Intellectual Property

Each party will adhere to the intellectual laws of its nation. Intellectual property developed during the visit of an exchange student/researcher/faculty/staff will be governed by the rules of the host institute unless otherwise specified.

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Any Background Intellectual Property (BGIP) shall remain the sole and exclusive property of the Party to whom it belonged prior to the commencement of this MoU. If one Party receives any BGIP from the partner under a clearly defined non-disclosure agreement, necessary and reasonable care will be taken to protect the intellectual property received.

The two parties shall jointly own results and Intellectual Property generated thereof for clearly defined collaborative projects and exchange programmes. Commercialization of such IPR shall be decided by separate agreements.

Article 7- Financing

The expenditure with regard to up and down fare and other arrangements will be borne by the Home Institution. Additional support, if any, will be governed by separate agreements that may be drawn up for specific activities.


Article 8- Legal Status


This document is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial cooperation and is not legally binding on both the parties. Any disputes shall be resolved through mutual discussion.

Article 9- Tenure and Termination of MOU


This MOU will be valid for five (5) years from the date of signing unless terminated by one of the parties. Either party may withdraw from this MOU provided written notification of the withdrawal is given to the other party at least three (3) months prior to the desired withdrawal date. This MOU may be renewed for another period of five (5) years upon mutual written consent of the parties before the expiration date.





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

It was clarified by the Director (DDE) that the prospectus is not printed and only its soft copy is uploaded on the website of Directorate of Distance Education. Facility of submission of Offline forms along with Online forms is made available to the students with different price. Further, the Advisory Committee recommended that as per past practice the option of submission of Offline forms be continued for ODL students for the session January & July, 2023 only. Additionally, a HELPDESK may also be established in the Directorate for helping the students for filling the admission forms through Online Mode.

13. The Committee discussed at length the proposal of collecting any fee upto Rs.10,000/- in one installment and were of opinion that it may affect the admissions adversely, hence, recommended that the existing pattern of fee submission in two installments may be continued in the Directorate for admissions cycle of 2023.
14. The Committee discussed the agenda item at length and was of unanimous opinion that the adoption of reappear provisions in all UG programmes will not only benefit the students, but will also improve the strength in all UG programmes.

In light of this, the Committee recommended that the relevant clause 8.1 of University calendar may be implemented in the Directorate from session January, 2023 onward for all UG programmes.

15. The Director (DDE) informed the Committee that ODL admissions for fresh candidates may be governed through IUMS portal from January 2023 onwards. It was also informed that the Directorate has also initiated the process to shift the existing data of old students of the Directorate to IUMS which will be completed at the earliest.
16. The Committee discussed and recommended that Internal Committees may be constituted to check the feasibility of revising the syllabus and scheme of all existing ODL programmes as per the LOCF pattern of UTD.
17. The Committee discussed the matter in detail and recommended that in case, any student deposits the excess fees through online transaction in Directorate of Distance Education Account, then in all such cases, 100% excess fees may be refunded back to the concerned students immediately after retaining the original fees of the Directorate.
18. The Committee discussed the matter in detail and recommended that only educational qualification may be checked for eligibility of students who take admission through Online Mode and no other certificate such as Migration Certificate, Affidavit, Gap Certificate etc. will be required for admission.

The meeting ended with the thanks note of Director (DDE) to the Dean Academic Affairs (Convener) and all the members of the Committee.

This memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered on the 12th of April, 2023 by and between the Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra (India) and the President and Fellows of Middlebury College d/b/a The Middlebury Institute of International Studies at Monterey (California, USA)

Kurukshetra University referred to as KUK hereafter is the first party to this agreement. It is a Multidisciplinary NAAC accredited A+ University that was established in 1956. The University offers a large number of graduate, post-graduate and research based programs in traditional and new subjects and in both the online and offline modes. It provides high quality learning experiences through a blend of classroom and field-based teaching.

The Middlebury Institute of International Studies at Monterey referred to as MIIS, is a California-based unit of Middlebury College in Middlebury, Vermont USA. The Institute offers masters' programs in the fields of translation, interpretation, localization public affairs, international security, climate and sustainability. MIIS is expanding its educational offerings to include professional non-degree training using both remote and onsite contact. It is home to research centers, including the Center for the Blue Economy, which will represent MIIS in execution of this Memorandum.

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Article 1: Objectives of Collaboration

The areas of cooperation may include, subject to mutual consent, any desirable and feasible activity that would further the goals of each institution subject to compliance of rules of collaboration in each country. The anticipated cooperation in various academic and educational activities are:

- Joint research projects and publications, including work by students at the partner institutions.
- Dual degree programs, Joint degree programs, semester exchange, and credit transfers.
- Faculty and student exchanges based on reciprocity.
- Reciprocal placement of students in paid internships and co-ops, when possible.
- Joint conferences and workshops.
- Visits by faculty, professional staff and students.
- Co-development of professional training programs related to ocean economics and blue economy policies, including development of short coursed (delivered online and either synchronously or asynchronously) and the recruitment of students for such programs from India and other countries in the Indian Ocean Rim Association.

However, neither party is obligated to any minimum of activities, nor is this Memorandum intended to preclude either party from entering into similar agreements with other institutions.

Article 2: Scope of MOU

This MOU shall act as the parent document and separate MOUs shall spell out details of future cooperation.

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Article 3: Academic Exchanges

The signatory institutions may, from time to time, exchange students for up to one semester in programs of comparable study. If an academic exchange is to take place, a separate MOU covering academic credit, financing, and related matters.

Article 4: Nondiscrimination

KUK and MIIS agree not to discriminate against any person because of age, sex, national origin, race, ancestry, color religious, creed disability and sexual orientation. Neither institution shall impose criteria for the exchange of faculty, staff and students that would violate the principles of nondiscrimination.

Article 5: Code of Conduct

Visiting students and faculty will abide by the codes of conduct of the host Institution.

Article 6: Intellectual Property

Each institution will adhere to the intellectual laws of its nation. Intellectual property developed during the visit of an exchange student/researcher/faculty/staff will be governed by the rules of the host institute unless otherwise specifies.

Any Background Intellectual Property (BGIP) shall remain the sole and exclusive property of the party to whom it belonged prior to the commencement of this MOU. If one Party receives any BGIP from the partner under a clearly defined non-disclosure agreement, necessary and reasonable care will be taken to protect the intellectual property received.

The two institutions shall jointly own results and Intellectual Property generated thereof for clearly defined collaborative projects and exchange programs. Commercialization of such IP shall be decided by separate agreements.

Article 7: Legal Status

This document is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial cooperation and is not legally binding on both the parties. Any disputes shall be resolved through mutual discussion.


Article 8: Tenure and Termination of MOU

This MOU will be valid for five (5) years from the date of signing unless terminated by one of the parties. Either party may withdraw from this MOU provided written notification of the withdraw is given to the other party at least three (3) months prior to the desired withdraw date. 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NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.4 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. - 2.13 **Industrial Training & Visits:** Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight into the latest developments / requirements of the industries; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its group companies and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The Second Party will provide its Labs / Workshops / Industrial Sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.
- 2.14 **Internships and Placement of Students:** Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the Internship and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs.
- 2.15 **Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of – Printing and Packaging Technologies.
- 2.16 **Skill Development Programs:** Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gaps and make them industry ready.

- 4.3 This Agreement will be valid initially for a period of 3 years. It can be extended further with mutual consent.
- 4.4 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their existing obligations

CLAUSE 5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

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




