भू-जल का 70% खेती में हो रहा प्रयोग : नागर

केयू में भू-जल संसाधन पर एक दिवसीय कार्यशाला, हरियाणा और पंजाब के कई क्षेत्रों में जल स्तर में भारी गिरावट

कुम्हड़ोत्र गुनिलसिटी के डॉ. रामकृष्णन स्वयं में रक्तवार को भू-भौतिकी विभाग व केंद्रीय भू-जल बोर्ड उत्तर पश्चिम क्षेत्र की ओर से एक दिवसीय कार्यशाला आयोजित की गई। भू-जल बोर्ड के क्षेत्रीय निदेशक अनूप नागर ने कहा कि भू-जल समाधानों के अंधाधुंध उपयोग ने प्राकृतिक असंतुलन पैदा कर दिया है। जिसके चलते हरियाणा और पंजाब के कई क्षेत्रों में जल स्तर में गिरावट आई है।

निरंतर गिर रहे भू-जल स्तर को देखते हुए 100 मीटर, 200 मीटर और 300 मीटर नीचे बोर करके पानी की स्थिति को चेखा जा रहा है। ताकि पानी के उचित प्रबंधन को लेकर बेहतर नीति तैयार की जा सके। अनूप नागर ने कहा कि सबसे ज्यादा 70 प्रतिशत पानी का प्रयोग कृषि क्षेत्र के लिए हो रहा है। वहीं 23 प्रतिशत इंडस्ट्री और महज सात प्रतिशत घरों में पानी प्रयोग होता है। ऐसे में सबसे ज्यादा पानी जिस क्षेत्र में खर्च होता है, उसका प्रबंधन जरूरी है।

इसके लिए टपका व फव्वारा तकनीक से पियचाई का अधिक से अधिक प्रयोग करने की जरूरत है। ताकि कृषि क्षेत्र में पानी की की लागत को कम किया जा सके।

जल प्रबंधन की दिशा में करें काम

: केयू कुलपति डॉ. केसी शर्मा ने कहा कि इस कार्यशाला से जल प्रबंधन में लगे सभी विभागों, एजेंसियों व लोगों तक संघीया संदेश जाएगा। उन्होंने कहा कि जल प्रबंधन में लगे सभी प्रोफेशनल, विभाग, संस्थान, एनजीओ और शिक्षकों को एक मंच पर आकर जल प्रबंधन की दिशा में काम करने की जरूरत है। उन्होंने कहा कि जागरूकता के साथ-साथ प्रभावी व कारगर

नीतियों से हम पानी बचा सकते हैं। भू-भौतिकी विभाग के अध्यक्ष प्रो. भगवान सिंह चौधरी ने हरियाणा और पंजाब राज्यों में विशेष रूप से पानी की कमी के बारे में बताया। उन्होंने कहा कि जल संचयन तकनीक से गिरते भू-जल स्तर को ठीक किया जा सकता है। इस तकनीक को अपनाने पर भू-जल स्तर के स्केट से निपटा जा सकता है। उन्होंने बताया कि इस कार्यशाला का उद्देश्य सभी को एक मंच पर एकजुत कर इस संवेदनशील मुद्दे पर चर्चा करना है। ताकि भविष्य के लिए जल प्रबंधन नीतियां व नई तकनीक बनाई जा सकें।

सरस्वती नदी पर चर्चा

कार्यशाला के दौरान सरस्वती नदी पर हुई चर्चा के दौरान छात्र वीरज कुमार ने सवाल पूछा कि सरस्वती नदी के इलाखकड में होने वाले संभल को लेकर बतलाएं जाएं। इसपर केयू के सरस्वती सेंटर फॉर एक्वाइलिस के डिप्टी डायरेक्टर प्रो. एमआर चौधरी ने कहा कि इस बारे में तभी बतलाया जा सकता है जब सरस्वती के पूरे पैमाने के बारे में पता चल जाए। इसके बाद केयू के ज्योडार्की विभाग के प्रो. एमआर जगतान ने सवाल पूछा कि सरस्वती के उद्भूत स्थल के बारे में बताया जाए क्योंकि इसे लेकर बहस की स्थिति है। इसपर प्रो. एमआर चौधरी ने कहा कि सरस्वती नदी के बलव स्थल को लेकर कई जगहों पर शिबिरी हैं, लेकिन अभी इस दिशा में पूर्ण जलवायु और अधिक शोध कार्य होने के बाद ही ही जा सकते हैं। इसके बाद सरस्वती नदी के बलव स्थल की खुदाई से मिली डेट के कालखंड को लेकर भी सवाल पूछे गए। जिनपर डॉ. चौधरी ने कहा कि सरस्वती नदी भारत की अजिम्मा से जुड़ी है।



National Workshop on Gender Equity in Science and Technology for Sustainable Development Feb. 21, 2019

संयुक्त राष्ट्र ने 22 नवम्बर 2015 के अपने घोषणा पत्र के माध्यम से प्रतिबद्ध 17 कदमों को 'विज्ञान में महिला एवं बालिका अन्तर्राष्ट्रीय दिवस' के रूप में मनाने की घोषणा की। इस दिवस को मनाने का मुख्य उद्देश्य विज्ञान में बालिकाओं तथा महिलाओं के निम्न प्रतिनिधित्व को ध्यान में रखते हुए उन्हें पूर्ण भागीदारी के लिए प्रोत्साहित करना है ताकि उन क्षेत्र में उत्पन्न चुनौतियाँ जहाँ को दूर करने में मदद मिल सके। विद्य के लगभग सभी क्षेत्रों में यह देखा गया है कि विभिन्न सड़िबिबदी तथा सामाजिक-सांस्कृतिक अवरोध बालिकाओं को विज्ञान के क्षेत्र में संलग्न की शुरुआत करने तथा उसमें आगे बढ़ कर पूर्ण भागीदारी करने से रोकते हैं। इस कारण वैज्ञानिक शोध तथा विज्ञान के क्षेत्र में उत्तम निर्णय निर्माण के पदों तक अत्यंत कम संख्या में महिलाएं पहुँच पाती हैं। अतः बालिकाओं में विज्ञान के प्रति रुचि जागृत करने, विज्ञान में शोध तथा प्रयोग कर पर भागीदारी के लिए समान अवसर प्रदान करने की आवश्यकता महसूस करते हुए संयुक्त राष्ट्र ने यह घोषणा की।

महिला अध्ययन शोध केंद्र, सुरक्षेत्र विध्विद्यालय तथा विज्ञान भारती, हरियाणा ने संयुक्त राष्ट्र के इन प्रयासों का हितवा बनने तथा उन्हें आगे बढ़ाने हेतु विध्विद्यालय के विभिन्न विज्ञान तथा प्रौद्योगिकी विभागों तथा सुरक्षेत्र विध्विद्यालय से संबन्धित महाविद्यालयों के महिला शोधार्थियों तथा प्रख्यापकों हेतु 21 फरवरी 2019 को एक द्विदिवसीय राष्ट्रीय सेमिनार 'सात विकास हेतु विज्ञान तथा प्रौद्योगिकी में लैंगिक समता' का आयोजन किया। इस सेमिनार का मुख्य उद्देश्य विज्ञान तथा प्रौद्योगिकी के क्षेत्र में शोध को बढ़ावा देना था। इस क्षेत्र में महिलाओं के नेतृत्व के पदों को प्राप्त करने हेतु प्रेरित करना व उनके आत्म विश्वास में वृद्धि करना था। इस कार्यक्रम में लगभग 150 प्रतिभागियों ने भाग लिया। पिछले वर्ष फरवरी 2018 में भी केंद्र तथा विज्ञान भारती, हरियाणा ने दो दिवसीय कार्यक्रम 'विज्ञान के क्षेत्र में महिलाओं की महत्वकांक्षाएं' का आयोजन किया गया था जोर इसी श्रृंखला को आगे बढ़ाते हुए आयोजी वर्ष में भी इसी प्रकार के कार्यक्रम आयोजित किये जाते रहेंगे।

कार्यक्रम का प्रारम्भ महिला अध्ययन शोध केंद्र की निरेक्षिका प्रो. रंजना अग्रवाल ने अपने स्वागत भाषण से किया। उन्होंने कहा कि प्राचीन भारतीय इतिहास को देखें तो अनेक महिलाओं ने विज्ञान के क्षेत्र में अपना योगदान किया है, बल्कि यह कहना अतिथोषित नहीं होगी कि हर महिला ही वैज्ञानिक है जो अध्ययन, प्रवृत्तिक विज्ञान तथा शिक्षिता पद्धति का उपयोग अपने जीवन में करती न करती करती हैं। उन्होंने कहा कि आज वैश्विक स्तर पर महिलाओं को विज्ञान तथा प्रौद्योगिकी में भागीदारी सुनिश्चित करने के लिए प्रयास किये जा रहे हैं ताकि उनसे भी मुख्यधार में सम्मिलित करके विज्ञान में लैंगिक समता को सुनिश्चित किया जा सके।

सेमिनार के उद्घाटन सत्र में अध्यक्ष उद्घोषण करते हुए सुरक्षेत्र विध्विद्यालय के मननीय कुलपति प्रो. कलाश चन्द्र वर्मा ने कहा कि विकास में महिला तथा पुरुष दोनों को बराबर की भागीदारी होनी चाहिए। हालांकि महिलाएं हर क्षेत्र में आगे बढ़ रही हैं तथा वे विज्ञान के क्षेत्र में भी अनुत्कृत योगदान दे रही हैं। परन्तु यदि हम इन महिलाओं को संख्या पर नजर डालें तो यह बहुत ही नागम्य है। आज के समाज में यह सोच व्याप्त है कि महिलाओं की शिक्षा की प्रवर्धकता दुल्हे दर्जे पर है। इस प्रकार की सोच को संस्कृति नहीं कहा जा सकता। यह अपमानस्पति है। महिलाओं के प्रति यह सोच हमारी मानसिक वृत्ति के कारण है। महिलाएं किसी भी दृष्टि से कम नहीं हैं। वे अधिक तथा उत्पन्न विज्ञान में समान रूप से अपना योगदान दे सकती हैं। उन सभी को गैरीता से यह प्रवास करना होगा जो महिलाओं व राष्ट्रियों को भी हर प्रकार की स्वतंत्रता दें। साथ ही समाज को पथिक वृत्तियों से स्वयं को बचाने के लिए सक्षम करना होगा। इस काम को समाज के सभी वर्गों को मिलकर करना होगा।

उद्घाटन सत्र में मुख्यअतिथि, फॉर्मर चार अख्यारनेस ऑफ़ नेशनल निस्वॉरिटी के प्रमुख संस्यक तथा सुप्रसिद्ध समाज सुधारक श्री इंदिरा कुमार जी ने कहा कि सात विज्ञान के क्षेत्र में विद्य गुरु रहा है। आज वह

महिला अख्यतन शोध केन्द्र, कुरुक्षेत्र विध्वविद्यालय द्वारा 28-29 मार्च 2019 को आई.टी.एन.एन.आर. उत्तर-पश्चिम क्षेत्रीय केन्द्र, चंडीगढ़ के सहयोग से दो दिवसीय कानूनी जागरूकता कार्यशाला "कानूनी जागरूकता द्वारा महिला सशक्तिकरण" का आयोजन किया गया। इस कार्यशाला में हरियाणा पंजाब, हिमाचल प्रदेश तथा चंडीगढ़ के विभिन्न विध्वविद्यालयों तथा महाविद्यालयों के लगभग 80 महिला प्राध्यापकों तथा शोधार्थियों ने भाग लिया। इस कार्यशाला के माध्यम से प्रतिभागियों को महिलाओं से संबंधित विभिन्न मूलभूत कानूनी अधिकारों तथा प्रावधानों की जानकारी दी गई ताकि वे जीवन में आने वाली विभिन्न चुनौतियों का सामना कुशलता तथा अल्पविबास के साथ कर सकें। इस कार्यशाला के माध्यम से प्रतिभागियों को न्याय प्रदान करने वाली एजेंसियों जैसे पुलिस तथा न्यायिक व्यवस्था के बारे में भी जानकारी दी गई जिससे वे सही समय पर अपने तथा दूसरों के अधिकारों की रक्षा कर सकें।

कार्यशाला के उद्घाटन सत्र में केन्द्र की निदेशिका प्रो० रंजना अग्रवाल ने कार्यशाला का उद्देश्य बताते हुए कहा कि महिला सशक्तिकरण के लिए कानूनी जानकारी उपलब्ध होना अत्यंत आवश्यक है। उन्होंने कहा कि इस कार्यशाला के माध्यम से महिलाओं को अपनी स्थिति को बेहतर बनाने में मदद मिलेगी।




कुलदेव की पुलिस उपप्राधिकृत सुश्री तान्या सिंह ने कहा कि इन एक ऐसे समाज में रह रहे हैं जहां इन अपने कर्तव्यों की बजाय अपने अधिकारों को ज्यादा महत्व देते हैं। पुलिस को तभी दिक्कतों का सामना करना पड़ता है जब इन अपने कर्तव्यों को छोड़कर इन समस्या के समाधान के लिए पुलिस पर निर्भर हो जाते हैं। महिलाओं के प्रति अपराधों में पुलिस को 99 प्रतिशत केसों में सफल मिलती है परन्तु एक बात यह भी सच है कि बृद्ध केसों की संख्या भी काफी बढ़ गई है। उन्होंने कहा कि केसों पर कार्यवाही करते समय दोनों पक्षों को सुनना जरूरी होता है क्योंकि परिवार, समाज तथा संस्कृति इतना दबाव बनाते हैं कि सही निर्णय लेना मुश्किल हो जाता है। उन्होंने कहा कि महिलाएं अज्ञानता के लिए खुद ही जिम्मेदार हैं। हमें अपनी क्षमताओं को निखारना चाहिए तथा अपनी कमजोरियों को पहचान कर उन्हें दूर करने का प्रयास करना चाहिए। आगे उन्होंने कहा कि आज की महिलाएं पुरुषों से काफी आगे निकल गई हैं वे हर क्षेत्र में काम कर रही हैं परन्तु पुरुष सामाजिक दबाव के कारण घरेलू जिम्मेदारियों से बचते हैं। आज पुरुषों को महिलाओं की बराबरी करने की जरूरत है। उन्होंने कहा कि समाज को आधुनिक रूप से महसूस करें तथा दूसरों को भी समानता दें। उन्होंने सभी प्रतिभागियों से प्रार्थना की कि वे लक्षित रहे तथा प्रयास से बढ़ने के तरीके अपनाएं क्योंकि पुलिस की भूमिका संरक्षणात्मक न होकर प्रतिक्रियात्मक है।

कार्यशाला के दूसरे दिन विधि संस्थान कुरुक्षेत्र विध्वविद्यालय के डॉ. अमित कुमार ने किमिनाता तर्क के अंतर्गत महिलाओं को प्राप्त संरक्षण की चर्चा की। विधि विभाग कुरुक्षेत्र विध्वविद्यालय से डॉ. प्रीती जैन ने महिलाओं के पुनरुत्थापक अधिकारों की चर्चा करते हुए कहा कि सरकार विभिन्न नीतियों के माध्यम से तथा संस्कृति विभिन्न मापदंडों के माध्यम से महिलाओं के पुनरुत्थापन पर नियंत्रण करती है। जबकि मानवधिकारों के अनुसार पुनरुत्थापन महिलाओं का अधिकार क्षेत्र है। अगले सत्र में विधि विभाग पंजाब विध्वविद्यालय की डॉ. सुपिनर ने बला न्याय जानून तथा घासों कानून की बातें कियें की स्पष्ट किया।

अंतिम सत्र में महिला अख्यतन शोध केन्द्र की पूर्व निदेशिका प्रो. अरुणा तंवर ने कार्यशाला पर महिलाओं का सैंगिक शोपन अधिनियम की विस्तार से चर्चा की तथा विभिन्न उदाहरणों के माध्यम से सैंगिक शोपन की परिभाषा को स्पष्ट किया। उन्होंने कहा कि सैंगिक शोपन एक ऐसा विषय है जिसके प्रति पुरुष तो बड़ा स्तर पर महिलाएं भी संवेदशील नहीं हैं। उन्होंने प्रतिभागियों को कहा कि वे इस विषय पर अपने महाविद्यालयों में गंभीरता से काम करें तथा शोधार्थियों को अन्याय से बचाएं।
