

Policy for Scribe

Guidelines for conducting written examinations for persons with Benchmark Disabilities/Persons with Disabilities.

Dear Sir/Madam,

Kindly refer to the letter Nos. F No. 34-02/2015-DD-III dated 29.08.2018 & F. No. 29-6/2019-DD-III dated 10.08.2022 issued by The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India vide which various guidelines have been issued by the Govt. of India towards the difficulties being faced by the persons with Benchmark Disabilities/Persons with Disabilities. Accordingly, I have been directed to issue the following guidelines to redress the issues being faced by the persons with Benchmarks disability/persons with disabilities during University Examinations:

- To accommodate/facilitate the persons with Benchmark disabilities/persons
 with disabilities & to avoid harassment to these persons, the Directors /
 Chairpersons / Principals of all the affiliated Institutes / Departments /
 Colleges will allow the scribe/compensatory time as per entitlement to these
 persons at their own level during the University Examinations. In future,
 such cases should not be sent to the University for approval. However, the
 cases of seeking scribe in the accidental cases will be dealt with by the
 University.
- For the purpose, the concerned candidate will give his/her request as per Annexure-A to the concerned Director/Chairperson/Principal.
- The facility of Scribe/Reader/Lab Assistant will be allowed to any person with benchmark disability/persons with disabilities as defined under section 2(r) & 2(s) of the RPwD act, 2016 and has limitation in writing including

that of speed if so desired by him/her. In case of persons with benchmark disabilities in the category of blindness, locomotor disability (both arm affected-BA) and cerebral palsy, the facility of scribe/reader/lab assistant will also be allowed. Furthermore, in case of other category of benchmark disabilities/persons with disabilities, the provision of scribe/reader/lab assistant will be allowed on production of a certificate to the effect that the person concerned has physical limitation to write, and scribe is essential to write examination on his behalf, from the Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/Medical Superintendent of a Government health care institution.

- 4. In case of persons with benchmark disabilities/person with disabilities, the qualification of the scribe should be one step below the qualification of the candidate taking examination. However, in case of blind candidates, the qualification or other such restrictions for the scribe/reader/lab assistant should not be fixed.
- There should also be flexibility in accommodating any change in scribe/reader/lab assistant in case of emergency. The candidate should be allowed to take different scribe for writing different papers especially for languages.
- Persons with disabilities should be given the option of choosing the mode for taking the examinations i.e. in the computer or in large print of question papers.
- 7. The Persons with benchmark disabilities/persons with disabilities will be allowed to take examination on computer system and accordingly, they will be allowed to check the computer system one day in advance so that the problem, if any in the software/system could be rectified, use of own computer/laptop should not be allowed for taking examination. However, enabling accessories for the computer-based examination such as keyboard, customized mouse etc. should be allowed.
- The disability certificate issued by the competent medical authority at any place will be accepted.

- 9. Compensatory time should not be less than 20 minutes per hour of examination for persons who are making use of scribe/reader/lab assistant. In case, the candidates with benchmark disability/persons with disabilities who are not availing the facility of scribe will be allowed additional time of minimum one hour for examination of 3 hours duration. Furthermore, if the duration of the examination is less than an hour, then the additional time will be allowed on pro-rata basis. In such cases, additional time should not be less than 5 minutes and should be in the multiple of 5.
- The candidates should be allowed to use assistive devices like talking calculator (in cases where calculators are allowed for giving exams).
- 11. As far as possible the examinations for <u>persons with disabilities should be</u> <u>at the ground floor</u>. The examination centres should be accessible for persons with disabilities to avoid confusion or distraction during the day of the exam.
- 12. The time of giving the question papers should be marked accurately.

You are therefore requested to ensure that the above guidelines are scrupulously followed while conducting examination for persons with benchmark disability/persons with disability.

	457	Further 3% horizontal reservation is also provided to Ex-servicemen/Freedom Fighters and their dependents by providing reservation within reservation of 1% of General category, 1% out of Scheduled Castes and 1% from Backward Classes category or admissions to the various educational institutions of the Govt. and Govt. aided/ institutes located in Haryana. As far as block allocation in Block A and Block B of Backward Classes category is concerned, year wise rotational system will be adopted. For example, if Block A of Backward Classes are given seats in the Academic Year 2019, the next Block i.e. B Block of category of Backward Classes will be given seats in the next academic year i.e. 2021 and so on. The concerned Chairperson/Director of the Department/Institute shall maintain a roster register for horizontal reservation of Ex-servicemen/Freedom Fighter & their dependents and carry forward all fractions till one seat is accumulated through different fractions over the year. As and when the total comes to one, a seat will be provided to the concerned category.
