Policy for Scribe

Subject: Guidelines for conducting written examinations for persons with Benchmark Disabilities/Persons with Disabilities.

Dear Sir/Madam,

Kindly refer to the letter Nos. F No. 34-02/2015-DD-III dated 29.08.2018 & F. No. 29-6/2019-DD-III dated 10.08.2022 issued by The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India vide which various guidelines have been issued by the Govt. of India towards the difficulties being faced by the persons with Benchmark Disabilities/Persons with Disabilities. Accordingly, I have been directed to issue the following guidelines to redress the issues being faced by the persons with Benchmarks disability/persons with disabilities during University Examinations:

1. To accommodate/facilitate the persons with Benchmark disabilities/persons with disabilities & to avoid harassment to these persons, the Directors / Chairpersons / Principals of all the affiliated Institutes / Departments / Colleges will allow the scribe/compensatory time as per entitlement to these persons at their own level during the University Examinations. In future, such cases should not be sent to the University for approval. However, the cases of seeking scribe in the accidental cases will be dealt with by the University.
2. For the purpose, the concerned candidate will give his/her request as per Annexure-A to the concerned Director/Chairperson/Principal.
3. The facility of Scribe/Reader/Lab Assistant will be allowed to any person with benchmark disability/persons with disabilities as defined under section 2(r) & 2(s) of the RPwD act, 2016 and has limitation in writing including


that of speed if so desired by him/her. In case of persons with benchmark disabilities in the category of blindness, locomotor disability (both arm affected-BA) and cerebral palsy, the facility of scribe/reader/lab assistant will also be allowed. Furthermore, in case of other category of benchmark disabilities/persons with disabilities, the provision of scribe/reader/lab assistant will be allowed on production of a certificate to the effect that the person concerned has physical limitation to write, and scribe is essential to write examination on his behalf, from the Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/Medical Superintendent of a Government health care institution.

4. In case of persons with benchmark disabilities/person with disabilities, the qualification of the scribe should be one step below the qualification of the candidate taking examination. However, in case of blind candidates, the qualification or other such restrictions for the scribe/reader/lab assistant should not be fixed.
5. There should also be flexibility in accommodating any change in scribe/reader/lab assistant in case of emergency. The candidate should be allowed to take different scribe for writing different papers especially for languages.
6. Persons with disabilities should be given the option of choosing the mode for taking the examinations i.e. in the computer or in large print of question papers.
7. The Persons with benchmark disabilities/persons with disabilities will be allowed to take examination on computer system and accordingly, they will be allowed to check the computer system one day in advance so that the problem, if any in the software/system could be rectified, use of own computer/laptop should not be allowed for taking examination. However, enabling accessories for the computer-based examination such as keyboard, customized mouse etc. should be allowed.
8. The disability certificate issued by the competent medical authority at any place will be accepted.

9. Compensatory time should not be less than 20 minutes per hour of examination for persons who are making use of scribe/reader/lab assistant. In case, the candidates with benchmark disability/persons with disabilities who are not availing the facility of scribe will be allowed additional time of minimum one hour for examination of 3 hours duration. Furthermore, if the duration of the examination is less than an hour, then the additional time will be allowed on pro-rata basis. In such cases, additional time should not be less than 5 minutes and should be in the multiple of 5.
10. The candidates should be allowed to use assistive devices like talking calculator (in cases where calculators are allowed for giving exams).
11. As far as possible the examinations for persons with disabilities should be at the ground floor. The examination centres should be accessible for persons with disabilities to avoid confusion or distraction during the day of the exam.
12. The time of giving the question papers should be marked accurately.

You are therefore requested to ensure that the above guidelines are scrupulously followed while conducting examination for persons with benchmark disability/persons with disability.

NOTIFICATION

In pursuance of Memo No. 65-SW(4)-2020 dated 23-01-2020 received from the Principal Secretary to Government of Haryana, Social Justice Empowerment regarding implementation of Section 37 of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (PWD) Act, 2016 – Special Schemes & Development Programmes, the Vice-Chancellor on the recommendations of the House Allotment Committee of the University has approved the following amendments for allotment of houses on the University Campus in anticipation of the approval of the Executive Council under Section 11(5) of the K.U. Act & Statutes, 1986:


- i) 5% reservation for allotment of house for the persons with benchmark disability with appropriate priority to women with benchmark disability in the University Campus as per provision given in Section-37 (a) of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (PWD) Act, 2016.
- ii) Houses in this category will be allotted by the Vice-Chancellor on receipt of applications from the eligible employees as per his/her entitlement in accordance with the provisions given in Section-37 of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (PWD) Act, 2016.

CHAPTER-2

RESERVATION OF SEATS AND GUIDELINES FOR RESERVATION

DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS

(A) The seats shall be distributed as under :

| Sr. | Category | Percentage |

| 1. | All India Open Category including Haryana | 15% of the Sanctioned Intake |
| 2. | Bonafide Residents of Haryana (State Quota) | 85% of the Sanctioned Intake (State Quota is equally divided into Haryana Open General Category and Reserved Categories of Haryana) |
| | (i) Haryana Open General Category | *50% of State Quota (i.e. 42.5% of total intake) |
| | a. Economically Weaker Sections of Haryana (who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservation for the Scheduled Castes, Backward Class (Block-A & B) other than category (ii) a & b below.) | *10% of seats reserved for EWS out of Haryana Open General Category seats. |
| | (ii) Reserved Categories of Haryana | 50% of State Quota i.e. 42.5% of total intake) |
| | a. Schedule Castes of Haryana | 20% of State Quota (i.e. 17% of total intake) |
| | (i) Scheduled Castes | 10% of State Quota (i.e. 8.5% of total intake) |
| | (ii) Deprived Schedule Castes | 10% of State Quota (i.e. 8.5% of total) |
| | b. Backward Classes of Haryana (except Socially Advanced Persons/Sections (Creamy Layer) | 27% of State Quota (i.e. 22.95% of total intake) |
| | i. BC (Block-A) | 16% of State Quota (i.e. 13.6% of Total Intake) |
| | ii. BC (Block-B) | 11% of State Quota (i.e. 9.35% of Total Intake) |
| | (iii) Differently Aabled | 03% of State Quota (i.e. 2.55% of Total Intake) If the seats reserved for differently abled persons remain vacant due to non-availability of suitable differently abled candidates, it may be offered to Ex-servicemen and their wards (1%) and dependents of Freedom Fighters (1%). |
| (iv) | Further 3% horizontal reservation is also provided to Ex-servicemen/Freedom Fighters and their dependents by providing reservation within reservation of 1% of General category, 1% out of Scheduled Castes and 1% from Backward Classes category for admissions to the various educational institutions of the Govt. and Govt. aided/ institutes located in Haryana. As far as block allocation in Block A and Block B of Backward Classes category is concerned, year wise rotational system will be adopted. For example, if Block A of Backward Classes are given seats in the Academic Year 2019, the next Block i.e. B Block of category of Backward Classes will be given seats in the next academic year i.e. 2021 and so on. The concerned Chairperson/Director of the Department/Institute shall maintain a roster register for horizontal reservation of Ex-servicemen/Freedom Fighter & their dependents and carry forward all fractions till one seat is accumulated through different fractions over the year. As and when the total comes to one, a seat will be provided to the concerned category. | |
