



Ragging shall include any act of omission or commission by any person indulging directly or indirectly in any kind of teasing, indecent behaviour including hooliganism, causing annoyance or inconvenience to the students or the outsiders on the campus and/or to the residents on the campus, as the case may be.

(b) Acts of indiscipline/misbehaviour shall include all such actions on the part of a student or a group of students, which in the opinion of the Vice-Chancellor/other authorities of the College/University are violative of any Statute, Ordinance and Rules and Regulations of the College/University, orders passed by the authorities of the College/University and are unbecoming of a student or may cause or have already resulted in disturbing the academic atmosphere, peace and tranquillity in the College/University Campus as well as outside.

6. Students' Grievance Redressal Committee


6.1 There shall be a Students' Grievance Redressal Committee to deal with grievances of the students admitted at various University Departments, Institutes, Schools and maintained Colleges on the Campus:

- (i) Dean Academic Affairs (Chairman)
- (ii) Dean, Students' Welfare (Convener)
- (iii) Proctor
- (iv) Chief Wardens (Men & Women)
- (v) Principal, Institute of Integrated and Honors Studies (in case the grievance relates to University College).
- (vi) Principal, Institute of Teacher Training & Research (in case the grievance relates to University College of Education).
- (vii) A student representative from each of the Faculties on the Campus.

6.2 The members of the Committee at (vii) above shall be nominated by the concerned Dean of the Faculty on the Campus in the month of August in every academic year.

6.3 Meeting of the Committee shall be convened at least once in each semester, preferably in the month of September and February of the academic year.

6.4 Six members will constitute the quorum out of which three should be student members

Minutes of the meeting of the committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor held on 22.08.2020 in the office of the Dean Academic Affairs regarding implementation of University Grant Commission (Redress of Grievances of Students) Regulations, 2019.

Members present

1. Dean Academic Affairs
2. Dean Students' Welfare
3. Director, IT Cell
4. Assistant Registrar (Colleges)

The Committee discussed the matter in detail and noted that such mechanism is already in existence but keeping in view the UGC (Redress of Grievances of Students) Regulations, 2019 reconstitution of committees may be done and resolved that :-

1. For College/Institute Students

Dean of Colleges may circulate for constitution of such committee (Annexure-I) to all Colleges/Institutes affiliated to Kurukshetra University with the direction to make provision of CSGRC on their respective portals.

2. For complaint by an aggrieved student relating to Department, or School or Centre on the Campus of Kurukshetra University.

Assistant Registrar (Academic) may circulate to all the concerned Chairpersons/Directors/Principals of the UTDs/Institutes, KUK for constitution of such committee (Annexure-II) with the direction to make provision of Departmental Student Grievance Redressal Committee (DSGRC).

3. Institutional Student Grievances Redressal Committee.

(i) Where a complaint does not relate to any academic Department, School, Institute or Centre of University Campus, as the case may be, the matter shall be referred to the Institutional Student Grievance Redressal Committee (ISGRC) to be constituted by the Vice-Chancellor as per Notification under clause-5 C is as under: -

- (a) Pro-Vice Chancellor/Dean/Senior Professor of Institution-Chairperson;
- (b) Dean of students/Dean Students' Welfare-Member;
- (c) One Senior Academic, other than the Chairperson-Member ;
- (d) Proctor/senior Academic-Member;
- (e) A representative from among students of the college to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor based on academic merit/excellence in sports/performance in co-curricular Activities-Special Invitee.

(ii) The term of the members of the committee shall be of two years.

(iii) The quorum for the meetings of the ISGRC, including the Chairperson, but excluding the special invitee, shall be three.

(iv) In considering the grievances before it, the ISGRC shall follow principles of natural justice.

(v) The ISGRC shall submit its report with recommendations, if any, to the Vice-Chancellor, along with a copy thereof to the aggrieved student, within a period of 15 working days from the date of receipt of the grievance.

The Vice Chancellor may be requested to constitute the committee as mentioned above.
4. University Student Grievances Redressal Committee as per Notification under clause-D is as under: -


- (i) The Vice Chancellor of an affiliated University shall constitute such number of University Student Grievance Redressal Committees (USGRC) as may be required to consider grievances unresolved by one or more Staff of DSGRC or ISGRC and each USGRC may take up grievances arising from Colleges, Departments/Institutions, on the basis of the jurisdiction assigned to it by the Vice-Chancellor.
 - a) A Senior Professor of the University-Chairperson;
 - b) Dean, Student Welfare or Equivalent-Member;
 - c) Two Principals drawn from the existing colleges, other than those connected with reports of USGRC under review, to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor-Members;
 - d) One Professor of the University-Member;
 - e) A representative form among students of the college to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor based on academic merit/excellence in sports/performance in co-curricular Activities-Special Invitee.
- (ii) The Chairperson, members and the special invitee shall have a term of two years.
- (iii) The quorum for the meeting including the Chairperson, but excluding the special invitee, shall be three.
- (iv) In considering the grievances before it, the USGRC shall follow principles of natural justice.

- (vi) Any student aggrieved by the decision of the University Student Grievance Redressal Committee may prefer an appeal to the Ompudsperson, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of such decision.





- c. asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student;
- d. Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
- e. Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students;
- f. Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students;
- g. Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it : sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- h. Any act or abuse by spoken words, e-mails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student;
- i. Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.
- j. Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background.
- k. All the senior students are advised to guide and treat junior students affectionately.
