<p>12 (b) <b>For Shastri :</b></p> <p>A candidate who has failed in one or more papers only obtaining not less than 40% marks in the total of the remaining papers in which he/she has already passed, shall be permitted to appear at the Supplementary examination to be held in the same year and/or at the next Annual Examination in that papers only, on payment of the same fee, on each occasion, as for the whole examination, and if he/she passes in that paper in either of these examinations, he/she shall, if he/she has also obtained the aggregate marks prescribed in Clause 11 above, be deemed to have passed the examination. If he/she fails to pass or fails to appear in both these examinations, he/she shall have to appear in all the subjects/papers <i>de novo</i>.</p>	<p><b>12 (b) For Shastri :</b></p> <p>A candidate who has failed in one or more papers shall be permitted to appear at the supplementary examinations to be held in the same year and/or at the next annual examinations in those papers only on payment of the prescribed examination fee.</p>
